(Arch sceptic [Geoff Falk](#) and "the Broken Yogi" argue that this is  a [neurological phenomenon](#). Even if this is the case (which it may well be), this does not refute its [subtle](#) or [imaginal](#) status. Even if the efefct is neurological, all that means is that the Cosmic Mandala affects the physical brain (along with the etheric body) in a certain manner, as do all phenomena of consciousness. Integral philosopher [Ken Wilber](#) is to be credited for arguing for  a [complementary and holistic multi-perspectival](#), rather than a contradictory and exclusivist, approach to the science of consciousness.
